## IN EVERY EMAIL

Ramp to Camp Emails share very important information to get you ready for camp. Please keep these in a folder to refer back to. ### Participant Management Platform

The Participant Management Platform is now available for Group Leaders to begin adding participants and monitor the completion of participant waivers. There, you can see all of your camp registration details in one easy view, showing you everything from contact information, your current registration number, and important dates (such as deposit and balance deadlines).

Using the buttons at the bottom of the landing page, you can easily navigate to the Group Leader Prep Center, request an emailed camp statement, and/or even make payments from this page. You can also email us to request changes to your camp information by using the [Email Us](#) button found at the bottom of the page.

Last year, **parents had the opportunity to select their camper's preferred Track Times at the same time they complete the digital waiver. We've implemented this again this year.** This means the choices will automatically populate into your Participant Lists. During the waiver request process, parents will have a link to view a video and a PDF that provides an overview of the different tracks we offer so they can make informed decisions. When parents enter their preferences, you'll see them on your list. You can always add, edit, update, or override any entries on your Participant List but the last submission—whether from a parent via the waiver, or a Group Leader via the Participant

List—will be the one that's saved.

It can take at least two hours for a waiver to populate in the "Ready to Add" section of your Participant Lists. Sometimes, it can even take up to 24 hours. If you're having trouble with waivers not connecting to your list, please email us.

**Important: Please do not share this link or your login details** with anyone except those approved to manage your registration and participant list.

You will need to enter your Registration ID and the email associated with your registration to access your unique landing page. We've added it below for your convenience.



## Camper Care Packages Pre-Orders

The Camper Care Pack pre-order form is live! Parents will inform you of what they would like to order for their campers using the last page of the Parent Pack. Once you've received all of your orders for your church, you will fill out the form below to submit your order to us. No payment is due until you arrive at camp. All of the Camper Care Pack colors, shirt sizes, and items are guaranteed if you pre-order them before the deadline. To ensure we can fulfill your pre-orders, the new **deadline to submit these pre-orders is May 1, 2026**. Please plan accordingly and collect your church's order information

before then.

## **ADULT VOLUNTEERS**

At CentriKid, our staff is trained and equipped to lead all aspects of camp, including Bible Study, Recreation, Track Times, and more. But there are some instances where we ask for some help from adults like you! In Bible Study and Track Times, a few extra hands really help enhance the experience for campers. We want to be clear - Orange Team will not be asked to lead anything or to be in charge, but instead to assist the CentriKid Staffer. There are many different ways this can look, but feel free to ask the staffer the best ways you can help them based on your comfort and experience level. ## **CHURCH GROUP TIME**

Church Group Time is one of the most meaningful opportunities for your church to reflect, reconnect, and reinforce what God is teaching your campers throughout the week. We've received some questions in the past about Church Group Time, so we wanted to share some helpful information with you all about it! This information can be found on [Step 6](#) of the Group Leader Prep Center.

### **What is Church Group Time?**

Church Group Time is a dedicated time each evening for your group to reconnect after a full day of camp. It gives you space to hear from your campers about their day, revisit what they learned, and reinforce the daily theme together. This time is designed to be relational, reflective, and a meaningful way to process the camp experience as a group.

### **What do you do during Church Group Time?**

During this time, Adult Leaders typically check in with campers about their day, talk through the daily theme, and create space for discussion, prayer, and encouragement. This is also a great space to share announcements, as it is often the last time your entire group is together before the evening winds down. A Church Group Time Guide is included in the Adult Leader Guide given to you at camp, and it provides suggested questions and simple activities to help lead the conversation. This guide is meant to support you while still allowing flexibility to meet the needs of your group.

### **Who leads Church Group Time?**

Church Group Time is led by the Group Leader or an Adult Leader from your group. This time is intentionally set aside for your group to connect after a long day of camp. Because you know your campers best, you are encouraged to lead the conversation, guide discussion, and care for your campers during this time!

### **How can a CentriKid Staffer help?**

Each group is assigned a CentriKid Staffer, also known as your Church Group Host. The CentriKid Staffers role is to support you during Church Group Time, not to lead it. Staffers are happy to help you find your meeting location, pass out materials, answer questions, or share their testimony (if invited to). They are there to serve as a resource and encouragement for you and your group! If you ever choose to do something different during Church Group Time, simply let your Church Group Host know, so they know where to find you or whether to join your group.

## DIRECTOR & ASSISTANT DIRECTOR TRAINING
